Latest communique from Bishop Shane...

In consultation with our COVID-19 advisors, and based on current trends in the evolution of COVID-19 in our region, I am announcing that on September 1, 2020, our diocese will move from RED to AMBER according to our <u>In This Together</u> plan. That means churches in the Diocese of Ottawa can aim to hold services, with restrictions, on Sunday, September 6 — with the understanding we will not move if conditions change for the worse between now and September 1.
